Leire San-Jose, PhD is Full Professor of Finance at University of the Basque Country in Bilbao (Spain). She has been Visiting Research Fellow at Huddersfield Business School (United Kingdom) working with Professor Chris Cowton during 12 years. She has been working with Edward Freeman at Darden Business School and Miguel Alzola at Fordham (USA), Eric Lamarque at Sorbona (France), Alex Nichols at Oxford and Audrey Paterson at Edimburgh (UK), Silvana Signori and Gianfranco Rusconi at Bergamo (Italy). She is leader of ECRI Ethics in Finance & Social Value Research group ([www.ehu.eus/ecri](http://www.ehu.eus/ecri)). Her research is focus on stakeholder theory and social value creation from sustainability view, so-called Social Accounting or Stakeholder Accounting. Her group has developed a model to measure the creation of social value of organizations; what reflects its social impact. Moreover, there is the possibility of using this model as non-financial reporting system. She was the Organizing Committee President at EBEN-Spain meeting on 2010 and ISBEE (International Society of Business, Economics, and Ethics) meeting on 2022, both held in Bilbao. Leire is part of Executive Committee of European Business Ethics Network (EBEN) since 2021.
